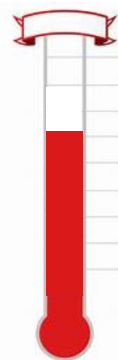

If you would like to continue to bring food donations, kindly bring your items to Mass on the weekends and place in the bin at the main entrance to the church.

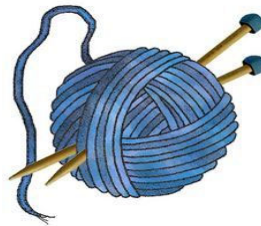

Pero si, al no tener fe, perdemos la esperanza, entonces el miedo nos atenazará y será cuando nos ahogremos. Con Cristo podemos vencer, como de hecho hemos vencido en tantas otras ocasiones. Sin él estamos condenados a hundirnos. Solo Cristo es nuestro Salvador y Él, realmente, es nuestro Salvador.

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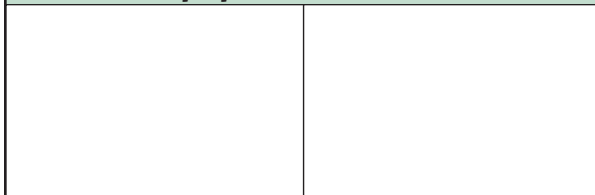
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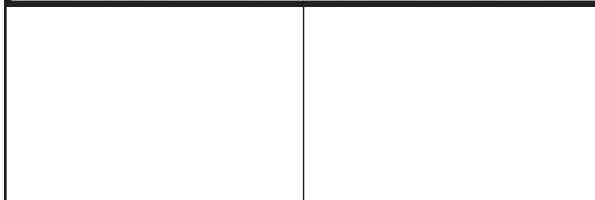
