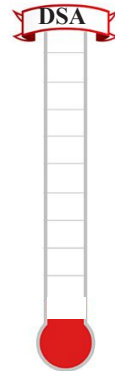

We pray 9 to 5 to protect unborn children and offer parents options to choose life. Shift leaders provide information about free pregnancy tests, ultrasounds and community resources. Shifts change every two hours: 9-11, 11-1, 1-3 and 3-5.

Before 2021, medical doctors were required to provide abortion chemicals in-person at an abortion facility or hospital. 54% of abortions today are chemical.

In 2023, FDA released “*guidelines*” that “*allow*” abortion chemicals to be prescribed through the mail and pharmacies to sell abortion drugs. This will eliminate a woman’s direct contact with medical personnel required by law to report suspected crimes such as rape, incest, and human trafficking.
