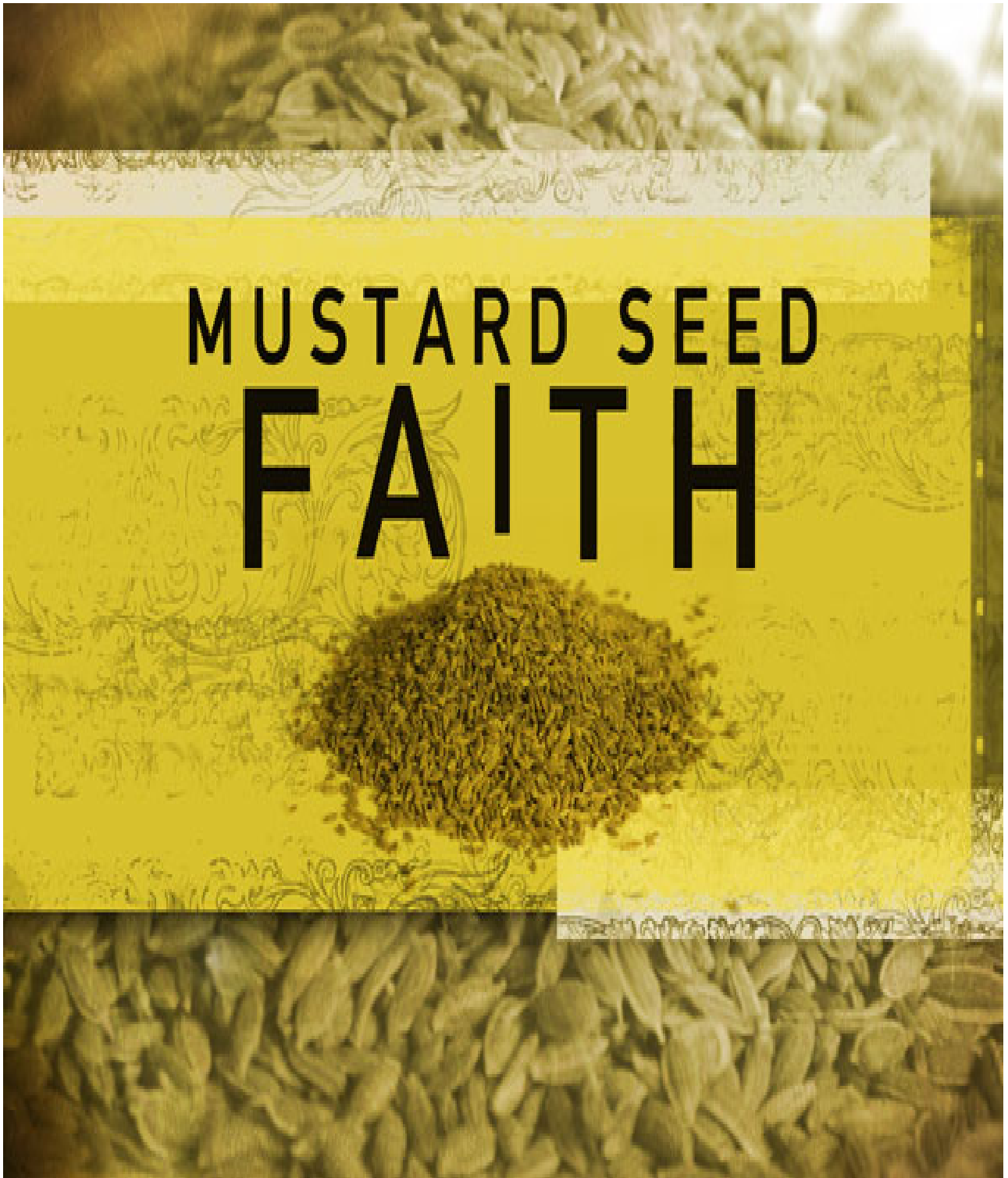

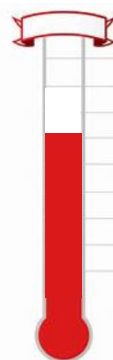

Diocese of Palm Beach

Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

I am very pleased to announce that the time has arrived for us in the Diocese of Palm Beach to return to a more normal attendance in church by relaxing the pandemic safety restrictions which have limited us for over a year. As of the weekend of June 19/20, the general dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass will no longer be necessary and will be lifted. However, one may still excuse oneself from attending Mass for reasons of health, tending to an infirm person, or out of concern for contracting or spreading an illness.

I am also pleased to announce that, as of the same weekend, the majority of safety restrictions in place within our churches will no longer be necessary. It is left to the prudent judgment of each pastor to determine what is best for his particular church. Church chapels may be used for weekday Masses and chapels of Eucharistic adoration may also be opened in accord with liturgical norms. However, for the present time, it will still not be possible to provide Holy Communion under both species as well as to fill traditional holy water fonts. The manner of the sharing of a sign of peace at Mass will be at the prudent discretion of each of the faithful.

Precaution and safety are the primary concerns which must be considered in the matter of wearing masks. In church, it is left to the judgement of each vaccinated person whether to wear a mask or not, while it is a just expectation, in a forum of trust, that an unvaccinated person wear one for the present time. Masks and hand sanitizers will continue to be made available in church.

I am deeply grateful to our priests and all of our faithful who have cooperated so well in following the safety precautions during this difficult time. You have made a Catholic church one of the safest places to be and we want to ensure that this continues for the future. The livestreaming of Masses and liturgical services have proven to be a great blessing and are still encouraged on a local level for the spiritual enrichment of the faithful.

We thank God for the progress that has been made to this point and ask His continued protection in remaining safe and healthy.

As we continue to move in a more normal direction, the following changes have been implemented at Our Lady Queen of the Apostles.

- * Masks are optional for fully vaccinated people and we have removed the distancing requirements on the left side of the church.
- * We appreciate those not vaccinated or those who feel safer wearing a mask to sit on the right side of the church where we will continue to keep the distancing recommendation in place.
- * We will continue to livestream our Masses through the end of June.
- * We ask that you, for the near future, to continue utilizing the offertory boxes. We will notify you when we begin "passing the basket" during the offertory.
- * Effective July 1, Saturday confessions will move back to our confessionals.
- * Our Cry Room is now available for families with young children.
- * We are working on plans to reopen our Adoration Chapel. We will announce the date soon.

- * We have placed all our tables and benches back in the pavilion. Please feel free to utilize them.
- * Coffee and donuts will resume as soon as we can make the necessary arrangements with volunteers. We expect to begin in July. More information to follow.
- * The parish office remains open as usual. We are available from 8:30 to 4:30, Monday through Friday. The office is closed for lunch from 12:30 to 1:30.
- * Masks are optional for fully vaccinated people. For those who are not vaccinated or those who feel safer, please continue to wear your mask when visiting the office.
- * Priests may request that you wear a mask when you visit with them regardless of your vaccination status. Please understand and bring a mask with you.
- * Our PREP schedule has not been finalized but we will be back in the classrooms in September. We will notify you of the dates and times of registrations as soon as possible.
- * We will begin utilizing Celebration Hall this month and we should be in full operation by September.

- * Unfortunately, due to the timing of our commitment, we will not be having a Pumpkin Patch this year.
- * We are planning a major 300 Club welcome back celebration in August. If you are a member, we will notify you.
- If you are not a member, call the parish office for more information.**
- * We will resume our New Parishioner Welcome Luncheon and Tour in September. This will be special as we have had many families register during the pandemic. We are looking forward to welcoming all of you with a special tour and luncheon. Invitations will be mailed in August.

We want to thank all of our parishioners and friends of Our Lady Queen of the Apostles for your patience and perseverance during this long pandemic. Thank you for respecting our requirements and your understanding of the timing of our changes. We also want to thank you for your financial support during these difficult times. Although our Mass attendance is only up to 55% of norm, our offertory is almost at 90%. In addition, our donations are also up over the previous years. Thank you to all who began utilizing online giving. This has helped us tremendously! Once you come back to Mass, there is no need to stop giving electronically. It is better for the parish and is very much appreciated.

We are in good financial position and we have great plans for the future of our parish.

Atendió con entera confianza los designios del Señor.

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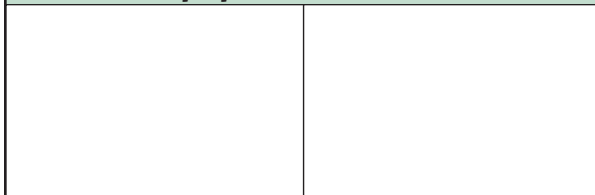
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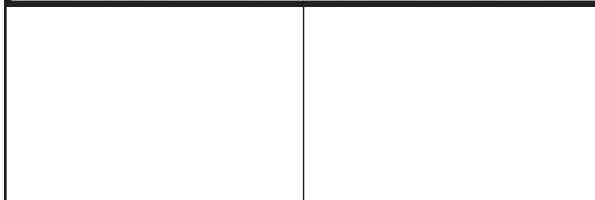
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
