



Please call or stop by the parish office and we will be happy to get you started. Travel plans for out -of-town guests should not be made until a date for the baptism is confirmed by the parish staff. A meeting with a priest *may* be required. We look forward to hearing from you.

Marriages: Please come by the parish office to start your marriage paperwork. Please allow six months to complete the paperwork. A wedding date cannot be set until a priest has been consulted.

**Sick and Homebound:** We are blessed to have a group of volunteers in our parish who are happy to bring Holy Communion to the sick, the hospitalized and the homebound. Please call the parish office to make arrangements if you or your loved one would like a priest to visit with the Sacrament of Anointing.

As we continue with our 2023 Christmas Festival and Village planning, I want to first thank those who have again stepped up this year and also welcome all newcomers. Volunteering is an important part of making our event successful. Last year we netted \$117k for our parish, and this could not have happened without you, **our volunteers**. While we still need help in many areas, you may ask yourself "what's in it for me?" Some reasons to share your time and talents include:

- ⇒ Making a tangible difference to help others
- ⇒ Using your skills and talents for good
- ⇒ Meeting & networking with other parishioners
- ⇒ Earning your PREP parent volunteer hours
- ⇒ Volunteering allows you to connect with your community and make it a better place

We have different levels of commitment:

Chairperson – oversee a specific area (kitchen, games, raffles, volunteers, etc) - In the initial phase, chairpersons meet once a month. As the festival approaches, and during the festival, more time will be needed to oversee your specific area.

Food booth captains – commitment is mainly during the festival - oversee the booth, prepare the food for serving, and instruct volunteers on preparing/serving and taking tickets.

Festival set up – commitment is during the week leading up to the festival - help with set up of booths, tents, signage, electric, decorations.

Village set up – setting up buildings and decorations, running electric and lights (over 100,000). Set up starts in October. Watch the bulletin for times and information.

Shift Volunteers – sign up to work shifts during the festival in the various areas – kids games, food booths, raffles, kitchen help and runners, hospitality, village characters. Note, due to insurance requirements, kids under 18 cannot work in the food booths that have fryers and grills; but there are many other areas for them to help.



#### **School of Christian Formation**


The Diocesan School of Christian Formation begins August 9th at 7:00 - 9:00 PM in Celebration Hall.
